On behalf of the Director General, Dy. Medical Commissioner (AYUSH) invites online tenders for DG ESIC Rate Contract No. Ay-10 for supply of Ayurvedic Drugs for use in ESI institutions all over India, through **e-procurement portal of NIC** - <https://eprocure.gov.in>.

**1. SUMMARY OF DG ESIC AYURVEDIC RATE CONTRACT NO. Ay- 10**

- 1.1 It is proposed to enter into a Running Rate Contract with Ayurvedic Pharmaceutical firms which fulfil the eligibility criteria approved by ESI Corporation for supply of Ayurvedic drugs, enumerated in the Drug schedules of tender document. The eligibility criteria have been given in the terms and conditions. Ayurvedic Pharmaceuticals Firms intending to participate in the rate contract should first ensure that they fulfil all the eligibility criteria as prescribed under the terms and conditions; otherwise the tenders will be summarily rejected.
- 1.2 The Rate Contract will be governed by the terms and conditions enclosed with this Tender Enquiry and no modifications / alterations etc. are allowed in any case. If any modification / alteration is proposed or any other condition advanced by the bidder, it shall be ignored and the bid will be disqualified.
- 1.3 Bidder is therefore advised to bid only if the terms and conditions as prescribed by ESI Corporation are acceptable to them in its entirety and they fulfil all the eligibility criteria.
- 1.4 To participate in e-tender, bidder should register at <https://eprocure.gov.in>. The bidders should complete all stages of online bid submission through e-procurement portal of NIC i.e. <https://eprocure.gov.in>. Bidder should not wait for the last date. They are requested to complete the process of online bid submission **well before the closing date**, in order to safeguard their own interest.
- 1.5 Evaluation & finalization of Rate Contract will be based on e-bid submitted by the bidder. It is the sole responsibility of the bidder to scan and upload clear and legible documents for the purpose of evaluation. Any deficiency in the document submitted by the bidder may lead to disqualification of the bidder and shall be the sole responsibility of the bidder. The document should be submitted as per sequential order given in the checklist.
  - a) **Tender bid is invited directly from manufactures in India falling only under category described as Class-I local supplier and Class-II local supplier as prescribed in order no. 31026/65/2020-MD dated 30.12.2020 from Department of Pharmaceuticals.**

**Non-local supplier whose local content does not adhere to the above said OM shall not be eligible for participating in tender process.**

Considering that the registration of Make In India compliant firms is dynamic and in cases where participation of Make In India Compliant firm against a valid exempted item under the list is observed in the tender then as a principle, the Make In India clause shall prevail subject to the Make In India compliant firm meeting the eligibility criteria.

- b) **In addition to above, Eligibility of any bidder from a country that shares a land border with India shall be governed by GFR 144(XI) (OM no. F. No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23.07.2020 and as per latest instructions issued vide OM No.F.7/10/2021-PPD dtd. 23.02.2023 and OM No. F.7/10/2021-PPD(1) dtd. 23.02.2023 and OM No.F.7/10/2021-PPD dtd 11.09.2023 issued from Department of Expenditure (DOE), Procurement Policy Division, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India and any amendments thereof.**
- c) **Distributors/Agents/Third party manufacturers are not eligible to participate in the tender.**
- d) **Participating Pharmaceuticals firm must not be (or proposes to be) a joint Venture/consortium except (new make In India-Joint Venture-MII-JV) as defined in PPP-Make in India OM P-45021/2/2017-PP (BE-II) dated 16.09.2020 issued from DPIIT.**
- e) **Participating Pharmaceutical firm must quote only one bid in one tender enquiry failing which all bids submitted by the same firm in the respective tender enquiry will be summarily rejected and all respective EMD's in the respective tender enquiry will be forfeited.**
- f) **One person as an Authorized Signatory can represent only one Pharmaceutical Firm in a Tender.**

#### **1.6 A Single Sealed Envelope:**

The bidder should put a separate sealed envelope in tender box containing

- 1) **Original Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque/ Bank Guarantee/ FDR of EMD as calculated.**  
Or Documentary evidence of EMD exemption: MSE and Startup firms are exempted from submitting EMD subject to submission of valid MSE and startup certificate from appropriate authority. The vendor need to do registration on Central Public procurement Portal (CPPP).
- 2) **Original Integrity Pact as per Annexure "H" on a Rs. 100/- non-judicial Stamp paper duly signed by the Bidder/Contractor as 2nd party. A single sealed envelope (containing above three envelopes) superscribed with the e-Tender for Rate Contract No. Ay-10 duly completed and addressed to Dy. Medical Commissioner (Ayush) should be dropped in the tender box kept in Room No. 315, III Floor, ESIC Hqrs. Office, Panchdeep Bhawan, C.I.G. Road, New Delhi – 110002 on or before 11.00 AM on 11.03.2026.**
- 3) **Original Label/s of all quoted drugs bearing Drug manufacturing License No. (As quoted in the bid), details of the manufacturer and drug composition. Photocopy/Laser prints of labels will not be considered.** Details of these label/s are explained in Clause No. 23 of this tender document.

1.7 The **prebid meeting** will be conducted by the ESIC in the manner and procedure as prescribed in e- Tender Schedule. An Authority letter along with photo identity card will be obtained from all the participants/ representatives of the Pharmaceutical firms / bidders attending the bid meeting with reference to the same. **Only one authorised representative from each firm will be allowed in the prebid meeting.**

#### **1.8 ONLINE TECHNICAL BID:**

The bidder should upload all the certificates / documents for the items tendered online in **Technical Bid**. The firm shall be liable to be rejected if complete documents/certificates/annexures are not uploaded and EMD/EMD exemption certificate, Annexure H, Original Label/s are not submitted in time.

1.9 Online Technical Bid and single sealed envelope will be opened **on 12.03.2026 at 11.00 AM** at the Vth floor, Committee Room, Hqrs, office, ESIC, CIG Road, New Delhi-110002 in presence of representatives of the Pharmaceuticals firms having an authority letter for representation from the firm along with their photo identity proof in support.

1.10 If any representative of the Pharmaceutical firms / bidders fails to be present and / or is absent from the prebid meeting, their presence will not be marked later in any circumstances. The absence of any representatives of the Pharmaceutical firms / bidders shall be the sole responsibility of the firm. **If a bidder does not submit any query upto the date specified in the pre-bid meeting, then no subsequent representations from them regarding the Technical/commercial specification/conditions shall be entertained.**

1.10 If the date of opening of tender is declared public holiday, the tender shall be opened on the next working day at same venue and time.

**1.11 PRICE BID ONLINE.**

The Bidder has to fill Annexure 'P' online.

Online Price Bid of only those bidders, who are found technically eligible, will be opened.

**The communication through e-mail will be sent to the technically eligible bidders.**

**NOTE: -**

1. It is the sole responsibility of bidders to check website(s) for further notifications / updates / corrigendum (if any) on NIC e-Procurement portal - <https://eprocure.gov.in> & **ESIC website -[www.esic.gov.in](http://www.esic.gov.in)**, *issued by procuring entity. Any corrigendum/addendum thus issued subsequently shall be considered as part of the tender document.*
2. It is the sole responsibility of bidders to duly check that all the documents/certificates/annexure/affidavits etc. are uploaded correctly and are legible to read.

## **2 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT(EMD):**

- 2.1 The bidder must submit Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) as calculated along with this tender in the form of Account payee Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque from any Scheduled Commercial Bank only **(RBI approved list annexed with this tender enquiry)** in favour of **ESIC FUND ACCOUNT NO.1, NEW DELHI.**

**Cheque(s) will not be accepted in any case.**

**Bank Guarantee & FDR** should be issued on the letter head of the Bank, strictly in favour of **“The Director General, ESIC Hqrs Office”** as per format annexed and bear the signatures of bank official, stamp and Employee ID.

- 2.2 The details of Drug/item wise EMD is mentioned in **Annexure - 1**
- 2.3 The total amount of Earnest Money Deposit to be submitted by each firm / bidder will depend on number of items for which the bidder is quoting the rates. The total EMD amount shall be cumulative value of EMD amount indicated in drug schedule for the drugs for which the bidder is quoting the rates.
- 2.4 **However, in all cases, a minimum EMD of Rs 50000/- would be submitted by the participating pharmaceutical firm/bidder** i.e. if the cumulative value of EMD amount indicated in Annexure – 1 for the drugs quoted by the bidder is less than Rs 50000/- (Fifty Thousand) then the bidder would have to submit the minimum EMD of Rs 50000/- (Fifty Thousand).
- 2.5 If a bidder submits an EMD which is less than that calculated as per clause 2.6, the available EMD will be adjusted for the items in ascending order of the serial number of items quoted by the bidder till the EMD is exhausted. Bid for remaining item shall be treated non-responsive for want of EMD and part value of EMD remaining unadjusted will be treated as excess value furnished.
- 2.6 The firm should fill EMD as per Annexure -1

For Example:

If EMD for Drug A shown in the Annexure- 1 is M1, EMD for Drug B is M2 and EMD for Drug C is M3, then total EMD would be calculated as :-

- 2.7 The Bidder must submit **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)** as calculated and as specified in Annexure - 1 along with this tender by means of Demand Draft/Banker Cheque in favour of **ESIC FUND ACCOUNT NO 1, New Delhi.** For Demand Draft the validity of the Earnest Money Deposit should be 60 Days from the opening date of the tender.
- 2.8 For FDR/Bank Guarantee: The bid security is to remain valid for a period of 45 days beyond the final bid validity period (i.e.270+45=315 Days).
- 2.9 **MSE Firms/start-up firms are exempted from payment of Earnest Money Deposit EMD).**
- 2.10 The EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be refunded to them within one month after the award of the contract. **The bidder should submit a request letter & pre-receipt with revenue stamp**

**affixed for the same at the time of bidding.**

- 2.11 In case bidder withdraws his bid within its validity or fails to deposit performance security within the specified time after award of contract, the Earnest Money will be forfeited and the bidder will be debarred for participation in tender enquiry of all ESIC institutions prospectively for a period of two years.
- 2.12 Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) deposited earlier will not be adjusted against this tender. **The tenders submitted without EMD/EMD Exemption Certificate will be summarily rejected.**
- 2.13 E.S.I. Corporation will not pay any interest on deposited EMD and would be stand credited to the E.S.I. Corporation Account.
- 2.14 **Bid validity will be 270 days from date of opening of tenders.**
- 2.15 **The bidder who submits false, forged, fabricated documents or conceals facts with intent to win over the tender shall be construed to be in violation of Code of Integrity as per the Tender Enquiry. The bids of such participating pharmaceutical firms shall be summarily rejected. EMD/Performance Security of such bidder will be forfeited and the pharmaceutical firm will be liable for debarring for a period of two years for participation in tender enquiry of all ESI institutions prospectively in addition to legal action as deemed fit.**

### 4. TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR GOVERNING DG ESIC AYURVEDIC RATE CONTRACT No. Ay-10

- 4.1 This tender enquiry is for the purpose of executing, Rate Contract for supply of Ayurvedic drugs in ESI

Hospitals/Dispensaries and other medical institutions run by the ESI Corporation and ESIS. The rates quoted and accepted by the Director General, ESI Corporation shall be valid for the quantities that may be purchased from time to time during the course of the contract.

- 4.2 The quotations shall remain open for acceptance for **270** days (Two hundred Seventy days) from the date of opening of tender.
- 4.3 The Director General, Employees' State Insurance Corporation, New Delhi reserves the right to reject any or all offers including the lowest quotation without assigning any reasons whatsoever. The Director General, ESI Corporation, New Delhi will also have the authority to accept bidder's offer in respect of any one or more of the items for which bidders may have quoted decision in this respect shall be final.
- 4.4 The Director General, ESI Corporation reserves the rights to invite separate quotations in his sole discretion to effect purchases outside this contract in the event of any urgent demand arising in a locality, where no stocks are held or otherwise.
- 4.5 ESIC will be entitled to proceed against the participating pharmaceutical firm/bidder before the court of law or otherwise to protect its rights and remedies available under law.
- 4.6 **a)** Bidder need not sign or upload the e-tender enquiry form while uploading this bid.  
**b)** However, their deemed acceptance of all terms & conditions of Tender Enquiry without any deviation must be submitted in Annexure C (affidavit) on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100 duly signed by Authorized signatory and notarized.
- 4.7 Bidder will have to furnish documents in support of the information given in the tender. Original documents shall be submitted for verification as and when required. If the bidder fails to provide such original or in case of discrepancies in such documents, it shall be construed as a violation of Code of Integrity. Such bids shall be summarily rejected. In addition, the bidders will be **liable for action as per clause 2.15**.
- 4.8 The bids submitted by pharmaceutical firms which are currently under debarment/blacklisting by ESI Corporation/Order of Debarment across all Ministries/Departments issued from Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India, will not be considered by TEC for participation in ESIC Rate Contract till the period of debarment/blacklisting is over and they need not to apply. Pharmaceutical firms for which debarment/blacklisting is over as on the date of closing of tender can apply.
- 4.9 Any drug quoted by pharmaceutical firms which is under debarment/blacklisting by the ESI Corporation/Autonomous bodies/Govt. Institutions will not be considered eligible for participation in ESIC Rate Contract. Pharmaceutical firms for which debarment/blacklisting is over as on the date of closing of tender can apply.
- 4.10 Adherence to clause 4.8 & 4.9 is mandatory for all participating pharmaceutical firms. Non-adherence to the same shall be construed to be in violation of Code of Integrity as per the Tender Enquiry and shall be liable for action as per clause **2.15**.
- 4.11 **In case of any attempt for cartelization by bidder with a view to hike up the prices, all bids will be rejected in addition, the bidders will be liable for action as per clause 2.15.**
- 4.12 The bidder, if selected, will have to supply drugs directly in the quantity ordered, to ESIC or ESIS Institutions. The Bidder shall not, at any time, assign, sub-let or make over the contract or the benefit thereof or any part thereof to any person or persons.

In case, at any stage of the contract, it is found that the approved pharmaceutical firm has appointed the distributors/dealers/third party agent for making supply or receiving of supply order against the contract,

ESI Corporation will initiate the following actions against the approved Pharmaceutical firm(s):

- a) 100% forfeiture of Performance Security from the valid current DG-ESIC Rate Contract
- b) Blacklisting for participation in the future tender enquiries for all ESI Institutions for a period of two years prospectively

4.13 Rate Contract shall be valid for two years from the date of finalization of the contract, but in case of exigencies, period can be extended for 01 (One) year on same terms and conditions for a period as decided by ESI Corporation and mutually acceptable. Exemption has been granted to ESIC Head Quarters to operate DG ESIC RC for drugs and dressings by the standing committee on GeM (SCoGeM), MOL&E.

#### 4.14 Foreclosure:

ESI Corporation also reserves the right to foreclose Rate Contract for any drug and or all drugs of DG ESIC Rate Contract, at any time within the currency of Rate Contract if procurement of such drugs is made available on GeM portal or in adherence to any statutory instructions issued by Administrative Ministry/Nodal Ministry/Govt. of India.

In case of foreclosure, EMD/ PBG of bidders, as the case may be, shall be returned back without accrual of any interest after the completion of recovery process and submission of No Dues from the users.

4.15 Rates for only such items, which can be supplied immediately on demand or latest within **six weeks** of the placing of supply order through out of the period of contract as indicated above may be quoted.

4.16 The ESI field units should assess the availability of the Ayurvedic drugs on GeM & procure at lowest (L1) price by following GFR Rules subject to the consumption as assessed at the time of procurement. If, however, at the time of procurement, item is not available on GeM, procurement from Rate Contract may be resorted to after obtaining Non Availability Certificate from GeM.

4.17 NOC for facility regarding import license for raw materials etc., will not be given by the ESIC/ESIS.

4.18 The Tenderer should submit an affidavit on Stamp Paper of Rupees 100 (Annexure-T), stating that the drugs, which are being quoted, are not banned under Section 26 (A) of Drugs & Cosmetics Act.

4.19 Quotation shall be strictly according to the required specifications and individual drug licence must be furnished in case of drugs as per Disease Category. The name of the manufacturer and brand name should also be written.

4.20 Book reference (A.P.I i.e Ayurvedic Pharmacopeia of India /Other authoritative Ayurvedic Texts) should be clearly mentioned against each drug quoted in case of Classical drug. Book reference (A.P.I/Other authoritative Ayurvedic text) may be mentioned for the ingredients in case of drugs as per Disease Category.

4.21 The bidder, if selected, will have to supply drugs/ items directly to the ESIC/ESIS.

### 5. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

5.1 Participating Pharmaceuticals firm must have a valid drug manufacturing license for the period specified along with thread of previous license if changed/extended/retained and the list of approved *products issued by the relevant Drug Authority (State Drug Controller/ Drug Controller General of India)* for the drug/drug quoted in their name and must submit an attested copy of the same. **Bidders who are marketing the drug**



**but not manufacturing will not be considered eligible.** *If above terms and conditions are not fulfilled bid shall be liable for rejection.*

**Note: Drug License for the quoted item(s) issued under “for export only” category will not be accepted.**

- 5.2 Participating pharmaceutical firm should submit a Non-Conviction certificate issued by the State Drug Controller/ State Licensing Authority, to the effect that the manufacturer has not been convicted under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and Rules, 1945 and there-under during the preceding three years for any of the drugs for which the firm has quoted price and that no case / proceedings is pending against the manufacturer in any Court of Law in India under the Drugs & Cosmetics Act. Non-Conviction Certificate must have been issued by the State Drug Controller within preceding one year from the date of the publication of the tender for the manufacturing site/Drug license/s which are being quoted.
- 5.3 The firm must have valid Non-Conviction Certificate from the Drug Controller/Licensing Authority of the State on Form 26 E3 of Drugs and Cosmetics Act. 1940 and rules made there under.
- 5.4 In case of Drug Licensing Authority not notified by the State/UT, Manufacturers may find Annexure-I in D & C Act. Attestation of the affidavit on stamp paper Rs. 50 by Magistrate not below the rank of first class may be submitted with the application to the concerned Drug Licensing Authority office. After the endorsement of the affidavit & application by the Drug Licensing Authority office, the same may be uploaded-
- 5.5 The participating firm must have a valid **WHO-GMP Certificate of the manufacturing site for the quoted drugs. However valid GMP certificate may also be considered where the drugs are not quoted from firms having WHO-GMP Certificate.** In the event of firm/s with WHO-GMP certificate being technically eligible for a particular drug, firm/s with only GMP Certificate will not be considered for evaluation for that particular drug.

**In case where any of the Drugs in this RC are available in GeM in future, the procurement of such drugs shall automatically stand excluded from the purview of this RC.**

- 5.6 A certificate from the State Drug Controller/ State Licensing Authority concerned (should not have been issued more than a year ago) that the firm has been manufacturing the product / products for which the firm has quoted the price, for the last three years. Firm should have completed three years' experience of manufacturing of the quoted drugs as on date of opening of the tender.
- 5.7 **In case of narcotics**, the participating pharmaceutical firm will have to submit the narcotic license issued by the licensing authorities.
- 5.8 **In case of Drugs quoted against Disease Category**, Participating Pharmaceutical firm will have to submit valid certificate from the State Drug Controller/State Licensing Authority else bidder's claim will not be considered.
- 5.9 The firm/company/corporation and or any of its director/proprietary/partners/authorized signatories should not be convicted/or a criminal case filed against or pending in any court of India by any Govt. department under Prevention of Corruption Act or for cheating/defrauding Govt./embezzlement of Govt. fund or any criminal conspiracy in the said matter.
- 5.10 For the drugs quoted in the tender enquiry, Participating Pharmaceutical firm will have to submit the samples on demand. If bidder fails to submit the samples within the period specified, the tender will be rejected.
- 5.11 Participating Pharmaceutical firm will indicate the assessed manufacturing/production capacity for each item quoted by him. **Firms will be liable for cancellation of the contract for any misleading information found at any time during the currency of the contract.**

- 5.12 The Participating Pharmaceutical firm / stores should be comply with the provisions of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and the Rules 1945 made there-under as amended upto date and Drug Price Control order.
- 5.13 The Participating Pharmaceutical firm shall submit an unconditional undertaking to supply drugs of standard quality as prescribed under the provisions of Drug and Cosmetic Act, 1940 (as amended) and the Rules 1945 made there-under as amended. The bidder shall also undertake not to supply items / drugs “not of standard”, “Grossly sub-standard” and “Spurious and adulterated drugs” as per the guidelines issued by the Drug Controller of India/State Licensing authority from time to time.
- 5.14 **a) Annexure S:** Participating pharmaceutical firm should submit a notarized undertaking on an affidavit of Rs. 100/- (Rupees one hundred only) (**Annexure S**) stating that:
- They will comply with all the statues & legislation regarding manufacturing, import, sale and supply of drugs in India and in particular the following Acts/Enactments viz.,
    - The Drugs and Cosmetic Act 1940,
    - The Drugs and Cosmetic Act Rules 1945 (as amended),
    - The legal Metrology Act, 2009,
    - The Drugs (Control) Act, 1950,
    - The Indian Statistical Institute Act, 1959, GST Act.
  - To supply drugs of standard quality as prescribed under the provisions of Drug and Cosmetic Act, 1940 (as amended). The bidder shall also undertake not to supply items/drugs “not of standard”, “Grossly sub-standard” and “Spurious and adulterated drugs” as per the guidelines issued by the Drug Controller of India from time to time.
- b) Annexure T:** The Participating Pharmaceutical firm should submit an affidavit of Rs. 100/- (Rupees One Hundred only) duly signed by the Notary (**Annexure T**) as under: -
- “The pharmaceutical firm hereby declare that the drugs/items sold to the ESIC/ESIS under this contract shall be of best quality and workmanship and shall be strictly in accordance with the specifications and particulars contained/mentioned in the description clauses hereof and the Pharmaceutical firm/bidder hereby guarantees that the said drugs/items would continue to conform to their description/ specification and provisions of law as stated in the contract and that notwithstanding the fact that the purchaser (inspector) may have inspected and/or approved the said drugs/items. If the same be discovered not to conform to the description and quality aforesaid or have deteriorated, the decision of the ESIC in that behalf will be final and conclusive. ESIC will be entitled to reject said drugs/items or such portion thereof as may be discovered not to conform to the said description and quality in the manner as prescribed. Such rejection of the drugs/items will be at the seller's risk and all the provisions herein contained relating to rejection of drugs/items etc. or such portion thereof if is rejected by the purchaser. Nothing herein contained shall prejudice any other right of the ESIC in that behalf under this contract or otherwise”.
  - The Bidder submits stating that the drugs, which are being quoted are not banned under section 26(A) of Drugs & Cosmetics Act of any other provision of law prevailing in India.
  - It is declared that the firm/company/corporation and any of its directors / proprietors / partners / Authorized signatories are not convicted or a criminal case filed against or pending in any court of India by any department of Govt. under prevention of Corruption Act or for cheating/defrauding Govt. embezzlement of Govt. fund or any criminal conspiracy in the said matter.

- The Bidder submits an undertaking that it is not submitting bid for any drug/combination of drugs which is not approved by DCGI/ State Drug Licensing Authority.

5.15 Company/Authorized Signatory has to submit self-declaration with details of Name of Company, Employer Code No. & copy of last three contributions towards ESI in case factory is covered under ESI Act. (It is mandatory to check all relevant details i.e Name & period etc. before uploading).

OR

Company/Authorized Signatory has to submit an affidavit giving address of Manufacturing unit with a declaration that this factory / manufacturing unit is outside the implemented area / notified area by ESI Corporation.

OR

Company /Authorised Signatory have to submit either a certificate from the Regional Director that the factory is not coverable under ESI Act, in case the factory is within the notified area or an affidavit to this extent.

5.16 The list of items for which the offer is being made should be given as per the format as given in **Annexure A&F**. All the columns of Annexure A&F should be properly filled up and no column should be left blank.

5.17 Each and every page of the bid submitted along with Annexures and affidavits should be signed by the authorized signatory of the pharmaceutical firm. The specimen signature of the authorized signatory should be submitted to the Corporation along with tender.

5.18 **Annexures – E:** Information as per the proforma enclosed (**Annexures - E**) should be submitted **as an affidavit on Non-Judicial Stamp paper of Rs. 100/- duly signed by the Authorized signatory & notarized with the tender.**

Furnishing of wrong information, false, forged, fabricated documents will be construed as violation of Code of Integrity as per Tender Enquiry. Such bids will be summarily rejected and the firm will be liable for action under clause 2.15

**Note: Please ensure that:**

- All affidavits within the bid tender enquiry should have serial numbers.**
- Care is taken in typing the correct format and language.**

5.19 **Annexure “C” & “G”:** Non-submission of **Annexure “C” & “G”**, not following all the terms & conditions of Tender Enquiry, furnishing wrong information and false documents will make the bidder ineligible and liable to be debarred/blacklisted from participation in tender enquiry of all ESIC institutions prospectively for a period of two years along with forfeiture of the earnest money. (**Note: Care to be taken in typing the correct format and language**)

5.20 Participating Pharmaceutical firms should submit valid manufacturing license issued by concerned State Drug Controller/Licensing Authority for all drugs (as per Drug & Cosmetic Act and the existing laws there under). Additionally, participating Pharmaceutical firms should submit valid State Drug Controller/Licensing Authority permissions for all Classical and Drugs as per Disease Category.

**5.21 Uploading Annexures:**

- The Annexure - P** is to be properly filled in excel (BOQ) and uploaded online.
- Annexures A, F, EMD, TO & Details of licenses** to be uploaded in excel as well as PDF format.

- c) Annexures & documents i.e B-I, B-II, D-I, D-II, C,E,G, H, I, S, T, TS, EMD, X, GST Affidavit, Copy of Pan Card, acknowledgement of last IT return and any other document required which are to be uploaded in the tender should be in PDF format, otherwise the tender will be liable to rejected.

**(Note: All the data to be counter checked for errors in typing, differences in pdf & excel format etc.).**

5.22 Merger & Acquisition of Pharmaceutical firm/s should be in adherence to Corporate Law and duly sanctioned by Hon'ble High Court or National Company Law Tribunal.

Such Pharmaceutical firm/s shall be eligible for participation only in cases where the merged Pharmaceutical firm/s are completely subsumed or form a new entity and cease to exist completely.

This should be submitted with all supporting documents including Board resolutions, Memorandum of Article of the new entity (if applicable), proof of Incorporation in Registrar of Companies inter-alia. **However, eligibility criteria of this DG-ESIC Tender enquiry will always prevail and decision of the ESI Corporation will be final and binding.**

**The eligibility of participation pharmaceutical firm as demerged entity will be governed as per instructions issued vide OM No. F.8/78/2023-PPD dated 12.10.2023 from Procurement Policy Division, Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India and eligibility criteria of this DG-ESIC Tender enquiry.**

5.23 All Certificates issued by Chartered Accountant must mention UDIN Number.

5.24 Notwithstanding anything contained in this document, it is hereby clarified that participating pharmaceutical firms which are otherwise ineligible but are entitled to participate in the present tender on account of interim orders/stay granted by courts/other authorities shall only be treated as provisionally eligible. Consequently in the event of the vacation/modification of the interim orders restoring the ineligibility of the participating firm the following consequences shall ensue:-

- a. Firms which become ineligible prior to the award of the final contract shall be ousted from the tender process with immediate effect from the date of vacation/modification of the stay order.
- b. In case the firms become ineligible after the award of contract, the contract awarded shall be liable to be cancelled at the sole discretion of the DG-ESIC.

**6. A. Terms & Conditions for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSE)** Firms quoting items reserved for exclusive procurement form them as per Govt. Circular no. 21(1)/2011-MA dated 25.04.2012 and 21(15)/2012-MA dated 24.05.2012 and any other Guidelines issued by Government of India as on the date of tender opening.

I. MSE Firms must have a valid MSE Registration Certificate A,B,C certificates issued by authority with any of the following :

- District Industries Centre
- Khadi & Village Industries Commission
- Khadi & Village Industries Board
- Coir Board
- National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC)
- Directorate of Handicraft & Handloom
- Any other body specified by Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India.

**Further, those MSE who are registered under CPPP (Central Public Procurement Portal) are only eligible to participate in the tender as MSE vide letter no. F.5/4/2018-PPD dated 28/02/2018, Govt. of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Public Procurement Division i.e declaration of UAM No. by the MSE vendors on CPP Portal is mandatory to enjoy the benefits as per Public Procurement Policy for MSEs.**

- II. In tender, for general category of item-eligible Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises quoting price within price band of L1 + 15% shall also be allowed to supply a portion of requirement by bringing down their price to L1 price in a situation where L1 price is from someone other than a Micro and Small Enterprise and such Micro and Small Enterprise shall be allowed to supply upto 20% of the total tendered value.
- III. Out of 20 % target of annual procurement from Micro and Small Enterprises, a sub-target of 20% (4% out of 20%) shall be earmarked for eligible Micro and Small Enterprises owned by Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe entrepreneurs.
- IV. Further, in event of failure of such Micro and Small Enterprises to participate in tender process or meet tender requirements and L1 price, the 4% sub-target of procurement, earmarked for Micro and small Enterprises owned by SC/ST entrepreneurs, shall be met from other MSE units.

**B. P-45021/2/2017-PP(BE-II) dated 16.09.2020 issued by Ministry of Chemical & Fertilizers Department of Pharmaceuticals. Further the categorization of bidders for consideration or applicability of purchase preference shall be governed as per instructions issued vide OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated: 18.05.2023 **from Department of Expenditure (DOE), Procurement Policy Division, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India (as annexed) and amendment thereof (if any).**

- I. "Local Content" means the amount of value added in India which shall be the total value of the item procured (excluding net domestic indirect taxes) minus the value of imported content in the item (including all customs duties) as a proportion of the total value, in percent.
- II. Bidder shall declare the % age of local content used in the manufacturing of drug(s) quoted in accordance with order issued by DPITT OM no. P -45021/102/2019-BE-II- Part (1) (E-50310) dated 01.01.2019 & 04.03.2021 and any amendment issued thereof.
- III. If the procurement for a value is more than Rs. 10 crores, the class-I local Supplier /class-II Local Supplier shall be required to provide a certificate from the statutory auditor or cost auditor of the company (in the case of companies) or from a practicing Cost Accountant or practicing Chartered Accountant (in respect of suppliers others than companies giving the percentage of local content as per pt. no. 9.b of DPITT order no. P-45021/2/2017-PP(BE-II) dated 16.09.2020.
- IV. **Bids with false declaration regarding local contents shall be summarily rejected in addition to punitive action under the MII orders and violating the integrity Pact as per tender document.**
- V. Annexure-X need to be submitted as per the format attached.

## **7. TURNOVER CRITERIA:**

### **Turnover for Ayurvedic drugs:**

- a) Average annual turnover of participating pharmaceutical firm in respect of all quoted Ayurvedic Drugs & Formulations for the last three preceding financial years (2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25)

should be submitted as per annexure T.O

Example: If Drug A has X turnover, Drug B has Y turnover and Drug C has Z turnover.

- b) Annual turnover of participating Pharmaceutical firms in each of the last three preceding financial year 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 to be eligible for participation in ESIC Rate Contract, for Ayurvedic Drugs and formulations should be as mentioned in Annexure -2.
- c) Annual turnover of participating **MSE Firms** in each of the last three preceding financial year 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25, to be eligible for participation in ESIC Rate Contract should be as in Annexure -2
- d) Annual turnover of participating **Start Up Firms** in each of the last preceding financial year i.e. 2024-25 to be eligible for participation in ESIC Rate Contract should be as in Annexure - 2
- e) All firms except start-up firms will have to submit online audited financial statements (Balance sheet and Profit and Loss Account Statement) for the above three years (i.e. **2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25**) in support of annual turnover. Audited financial statement (Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account Statement) in respect of annual turnover for the firm as a whole by highlighting the turnover for Ayurvedic drugs and formulations for the above three years (i.e. 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25) in support of annual turnover & **Certificate by Chartered Accountant** giving sales turnover in respect of Ayurvedic drugs only. Turnover should be in respect of firm submitting the tender. **Group turnover (other than Ayurvedic drugs and their formulations) will not be considered for determining the eligibility and such tenders will be rejected summarily.**
- f) **Twenty Five Percent (25%) or more** of the annual turnover shall be from the trading in open market, including export data, from Ayurvedic drugs & formulations only (excluding sale of Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients or Bulk Drugs) i.e. exclusive of supply to ESI/Government Departments and 3rd Party Sale. A certificate from the Chartered Accountant (With UDIN no.) with reference to sale in the open market/sale to the third party should be submitted (Annexure TS)
- g) The firm should submit Annexure TO (as per format).
- h) If a bidder submits Turnover which is less than that calculated as above 7. a), the available Turnover will be adjusted for the items in ascending order of the serial number of items quoted by the bidder till the Turnover is exhausted. Bid for remaining item shall be treated non-responsive for want of Turnover.

## **8. PERFORMANCE SECURITY:**

- 8.1 All Successful bidders including MSE bidder will deposit the Performance Security (5%) equal to Cumulative amount of all the awarded drug(s) in the form of Demand Draft/ Banker's Cheque of Scheduled Commercial Bank only (**RBI approved list annexed with this tender enquiry**).

Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque in favour of **ESIC FUND ACCOUNT NO 1, New Delhi.**

Bank Guarantee and FDR should be strictly in favour of “**The Director General, ESIC Hqrs. Office**” as per format annexed. Individual Performance Security amount for each drug has been indicated in Drug Schedule.

The total amount **Performance Security** to be submitted by each successful bidder/s will depend on number of items awarded to the bidder. **The Performance Security amount shall be cumulative value of Performance Security amount indicated in drug schedule.**

However, in all cases a **minimum Performance Security of Rs 100000/- (Rs. One Lakh)** needs to be submitted by the all successful bidder/s i.e. if the cumulative value of **Performance Security** amount indicated in **Annexure – 1** for the drugs awarded to the bidder is less than Rs 100000/- (Rs. One Lakh) then the bidder shall submit the **minimum Performance Security of Rs 100000/- (Rs. One Lakh).**

8.2 Director General, ESI Corporation will be at liberty to apportion any amount due and payable by the bidder to ESIC/ESIS in respect of Non-supply / Non-Performance / risk purchase by the ESIC/ESIS against drugs of “Not of Standard Quality” or any other amount which becomes payable by the bidder in favour of ESIC by virtue of the terms and conditions agreed herein and recover the same from the Performance Security or from any other contract place with bidder. No appeal shall lie with any authority against the decision taken by him in pursuance of this clause and decision of the DG, ESIC shall be final.

8.3 EMD of the successful bidder will not be adjusted as part of performance security.

8.4 Performance security must be deposited within 15 days of award of contract and will remain valid for a period of 60 days beyond the date of compliance of all contractual observations.

8.5 Performance security shall be released (after the completion of validity of Bank Guarantee) within one month of submission of No dues from the User unit and no pending recovery certificate from the approved pharmaceutical firms.

## **9. MARKING /LABELLING:**

9.1 Each packing shall be printed with nomenclature of the drug and shall be labelled in accordance with the requirement of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and Rules 1945 made there-under. Packing and packaging of each drug must comply with the procedure provided under the legal Metrology Act, 2009 and rules made there under.

9.2 The Quick Response (QR) Code for Ayurveda drugs is applicable if, GOI issues guidelines in future, during the currency of contract.

## **10. PACKING**

10.1 Tendering firms must quote for the packing specified against each item in the Drug schedule as per tender enquiry, as any other packing may not be accepted. Rate should be quoted strictly as per specification given in the tender enquiry.

10.2 **It should be ensured that all labels of cartons, ampoules, vials, bottles, jars, tubes, tins, containers etc., have "For ESI supply, Not to be sold" imprinted/rubber stamping with indelible ink clearly. Any consignment without such stamping will not be considered valid and will be rejected.**

10.3 Loose supplies/damaged packing/tempered or damaged labelled supplies shall not be accepted under any circumstances.

10.4 Rates should be quoted for **packing size as given in Drug schedule of tender enquiry.** Participating Pharmaceutical firms / bidders shall quote the net price per Unit as defined in Drug Schedule and BOQ of this tender enquiry.

10.5 Supplies to be made in **proper Boxes.**

10.6 Liquid orals to be supplied in Glass bottles / food grade plastic bottles conforming Drugs & Cosmetics Act and Ayurvedic Pharmacopoeia.

10.7 It should be ensured that only first use packaging material, of uniform size including bottles is used for making supplies on the basis of ESI Rate Contract.

10.8 All primary packing container should be strictly conforming to the specification included in the relevant pharmacopoeia packing should be able to prevent damage or deterioration during transit.

10.9 All containers i.e., bottles, tins, cartons, etc., are required to be secured with pilfer proof seal to ensure genuineness of the product packed and other correctness of contents. No butter paper is to be used for packing of sealing

10.10 Asava, Arishta Taila, Kwatha (Pravahi), Ghrita, Avaleha, Lavanas and Kshara preparations must be supplied in glass /food grade plastic bottles.

10.11 Avaleha in syrup form should be, supplied in narrow mouth glass food grade plastic bottles.

10.12 Avalehas and Ghritas should be supplied in wide mouth glass / food grade plastic bottles.

10.13 Churna and kwatha coarse powder should be supplied in tin/plastic packings.

10.14 The weight of each pill/tablet of drugs packing 2 gm should be 100 mg.

10.15 The weight of each pill/tablet of Karpoor Rasa & Vedanantak Rasa/Vati should be 100 mg.

10.16 The weight of each pill/tablet in respect of remaining rasa and vati, ghanavati, guggulu, lauha and mandura preparations specified in the list should be followed.

10.17 The labels of all the medicines to be supplied must be written in Hindi or in English.

The printing of labels of each approved item must be different in colour, if possible.

## **11. SHELF LIFE AS ON DATE:**

11.1 For Drugs having shelf life of two years or less: As on date of delivery, Drug supplied should not be older than one fourth (1/4) of its shelf life from the date of manufacture.

11.2 For Drugs having shelf life more than two years: As on date of delivery, Drug supplied should not be older than one sixth (1/6) of its shelf life from the date of manufacturing.

11.3 All Drug Preparations supplied should comply with shelf life period as per guidelines of A.P.I.

11.4 The manufacturing date, expiry date, batch no. and main composition must be written clearly on each bottle, packets, phials etc., in respect of each lot offered by the firm against the contract. The batch number and manufacturing date must be incorporated on bottle, packets and phials and it should be same as on outer cover (carton).

However, the consignee may relax this criteria in case of exigencies with reasons duly recorded and shall be responsible for use of that stores within its given shelf life, with a suitable undertaking from the supplier, the terms of which shall be decided by the consignee as per the requirement of the stores and usage pattern. The Consignee should ensure that there should not be any loss to the Corporation.

## **12. TESTING OF DRUGS:**

12.1 Approved Rate Contract Holder should mandatorily submit a Test Report that particular batch of medicines tested by the Government/ Government approved Laboratories (as per list circulated from ESIC Hqrs./ Hospitals/ State Govt. from time to time) along with each supply.



12.2 Regular and random testing of drugs will be under taken by ESI from Govt./Govt. approved laboratories at the time of supply. Additional quality testing may also be undertaken by ESI Institutions at any time during the shelf life or whenever any defect is noticed.

12.3 The Director General, ESI Corporation shall be at liberty to undertake regular and random testing of the drugs supplied by the pharmaceuticals firm/bidder at regular interval to maintain and ensure the quality of drugs.

12.4 The report of the Govt./ Govt. approved laboratory shall be accepted by the firm. In case the same is disputed by the firm giving reasons, the report of the Ayurvedic Pharmacopoeia Laboratory/any other Central Drug Laboratory only will be accepted as final and the same should be submitted within three months from the date, the disputed test report is communicated to the firm. For this, the firm should approach the concerned Drug Control Authorities for getting the drugs tested as per procedure from the designated Central Drug Laboratory **at their own cost.**

### **13. QUALITY CONTROL:**

13.1 The firm should comply with the provisions of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and the Rules made there under as and Drug Price Control order.

13.2 If any drugs supplied against this Rate Contract are found to be not of standard quality on inspection by Competent Authority, the pharmaceutical firm will be liable to replace the entire quantity within 15 days otherwise risk purchase will be charged from the company and the cost of testing will be recovered from the supplier.

13.3 If any drug supplied against this Rate Contract are found to be not of standard quality on test analysis from approved laboratory and / or on inspection by competent authority, The Firm/Bidder will be liable to replace the entire quantity or make full payment of entire consignment against the particular invoice irrespective of fact that part or whole of the supplied stores may have been consumed & the cost of testing will be recovered from the supplier.

13.4 **The classification of defects into different categories is as per the guidelines issued by the Drug Controller of India & action will be taken by ESIC for each category of defects, described as under:**

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#### **A. FOR CATEGORY 'A' DEFECT (Spurious / Adulterated Drugs)-**

**If any item / Batch of the item declared Not of Standard quality (NSQ) under Category A, in Ay-10 DGESIC Rate Contract/s.**

- Recall of the NSQ item immediately from all ESIC/ ESIS User Units. Recoveries to be initiated by the DDO's wherever payment had been made already.
- Forfeiture of Performance Security from the respective DGESIC Rate Contract for all the drugs quoted.
- Debarring of the Rate Contract holder / Pharmaceutical firm from current and all future DG ESIC Rate Contract for participation in tender enquiry of all ESIC institution prospectively for a period of two (2) years.
- Rate Contract Holder/ Pharmaceutical firm will be liable to pay damages/ compensation (if any) to individual/ individuals arising due to consumption of item declared NSQ and in case of any adverse reaction reported in the Hospital during administration of the drug.

#### **B. FOR CATEGORY 'B' DEFECT (Grossly Substandard Drugs)**

**1. If single Item/ Batch of item is declared NSQ under Category B in Ay-10 DGESIC Rate Contract/s.**

- Recall of the NSQ item immediately from all ESIC/ ESIS User Units. Replacement to items/Recovery of payment to be initiated by the DDO's wherever payment had been made already.
- 20% Forfeiture of Performance Security from the respective DGESIC Rate Contract for that drug as per clause 2.15 of T.E.
- Warning to be issued to the firm for the NSQ of TE.
- Testing of the three subsequent supplies of the same item by the same firm (as declared NSQ) to be carried out by the same user unit from where the sample has been originally reported as NSQ
- Cost of subsequent testing charges to be recovered from forthcoming bills of the pharmaceutical firm.
- Rate Contract Holder/ Pharmaceutical firm will be liable to pay damages/ compensation (if any) to individual/individuals arising due to consumption of item declared NSQ and in case of any adverse reaction reported in the Hospital during administration of the drugs.

**2. a) If more than one Item supplied by individual pharmaceutical firm is declared NSQ under Category B in Ay-10 DGESIC Rate Contract.**

- Recall of the NSQ item immediately from all ESIC/ ESIS User Units. Replacement to items/Recovery of payment to be initiated by the DDO's wherever payment had been made already.
- 50% (20%+30%) Forfeiture of Performance Security from the respective DGESIC Rate Contract for this item (2<sup>nd</sup> NSQ) as per clause 2.15 of T.E
- Warning to be issued to the firm for the NSQ item.
- Testing of the three subsequent supplies of the same item by the same firm (as declared NSQ) to be carried out by the same user unit from where the sample has been originally reported as NSQ.
- Cost of subsequent testing charges to be recovered from forthcoming bills of the pharmaceutical firm.
- **Any Subsequent (3<sup>rd</sup> onwards) NSQ reported of the individual Pharmaceutical firm will lead to debarment for all the NSQ declared items from current and all future DGESIC Rate contract for a period of two years for participation in all ESI Institution prospectively along with forfeiture of 100% performance security for all NSQ declared items.**
- Rate Contract Holder/ Pharmaceutical firm will be liable to pay damages/ compensation (if any) to individual/ individuals arising due to consumption of item declared NSQ and in case of any adverse reaction reported in the Hospital during administration of the drugs.

**b) If more than one Batch of the same item belonging to any individual pharmaceutical firm is declared NSQ under Category B within a year in Ay-10 DG ESIC Rate Contract.**

- Recall of the NSQ item immediately from all ESIC/ ESIS User Units. Replacement to items/Recovery of payment to be initiated by the DDO's (wherever payment had been made already).
- 100% Forfeiture of Performance Security from the respective DGESIC Rate Contract for this item (2<sup>nd</sup> NSQ) as per clause 2.15 of T.E
- Debarring of Rate Contract Holder/Pharmaceuticals firm immediately from current and all future DG ESIC Rate Contracts for the item for a period of two year for participation in all ESI Institution

prospectively.

- Rate Contract Holder/ Pharmaceutical firm will be liable to pay damages/ compensation (if any) to individual/ individuals arising due to consumption of item declared NSQ and in case of any adverse reaction reported in the Hospital during administration of the drugs.

### **C. FOR CATEGORY C DEFECT (Minor Defects)**

#### **1. If single item/ Batch of item is declared NSQ under Category C in Ay-10 DG ESIC Rate Contract.**

- Recall of the NSQ item immediately from all ESIC/ ESIS User Units. Replacement of items/Recoveries of payment to be initiated by the DDO's (wherever payment had been made already).
- Rate Contract Holder/ Pharmaceutical firm will be liable to pay damages/ compensation (if any) to individual/ individuals arising due to consumption of item declared NSQ and in case of any adverse reaction reported in the Hospital during administration of the drugs.

#### **2. a) If more than one item/ Batch of item belonging to any individual pharmaceutical firm is declared NSQ under Category C within a year in Ay-10 DGESIC Rate Contract.**

- Recall of the NSQ item immediately from all ESIC/ ESIS User Units. Replacement of items/Recovery of payment to be initiated by the DDO's (wherever payment had been made already).
- Warning to be issued to the firm for the NSQ item.
- Rate Contract Holder/ Pharmaceutical firm will be liable to pay damages/ compensation (if any) to individual/ individuals arising due to consumption of item declared NSQ and in case of any adverse reaction reported in the Hospital during administration of the drugs.

#### **b) If more than one Batch of the same item belonging to any individual pharmaceutical firm is declared NSQ under category C within a year in DG ESIC Rate Contract Ay-10.**

- Recall of the NSQ item immediately from all ESIC/ ESIS User Units. Replacement of items/Recovery of payment to be initiated by the DDO's (wherever payment had been made already).
- 10 % Forfeiture of Performance Security from the respective DGESIC Rate Contract for the item (2nd NSQ) as per clause 2.15 of T.E
- Any subsequent (2nd onwards) NSQ reported of the individual Pharmaceuticals firm will lead to debarment for all the NSQ declared items from current DGESIC Rate Contracts.
- Warning to be issued to the firm for the NSQ item.
- Rate Contract Holder/ Pharmaceutical firm will be liable to pay damages/ compensation (if any) to individual/ individuals arising due to consumption of item declared NSQ and in case of any adverse reaction reported in the Hospital during administration of the drugs.

### **14. PURCHASE ORDER:**

- 14.1 After the quotations have been accepted by the Director General, ESI Corporation, purchase orders will be placed by the Director Medical Delhi/MS of ESIC/ESIS hospitals/Directors of ESI Scheme of various States, who for the purpose of this Rate Contract, shall be designated as Chief Direct Demanding Officer and will exercise the powers of Director General, ESI Corporation in all matters connected with the execution of supplies and/or wherever specifically provided in the terms and

conditions of the Rate Contract. The Chief Direct Demanding Officer can also designate any of his subordinate Officers as Direct Demanding Officer (DDO) to operate this contract.

- 14.2 Purchase order will be placed from time to time during the contract period in which the exact quantities required on each occasion together with the date of delivery shall be specified by the Direct Demanding Officers.
- 14.3 **No guarantee can be given as to the minimum quantity** which will be drawn against this contract but the pharmaceutical firm will supply quantity as may be ordered by the Direct Demanding Officer during the currency of the contract.
- 14.4 Purchase orders against the contract will be accepted as long as these reach the pharmaceutical firm on or before last date of the contract. Purchase orders received during the closing days should be complied with in due course, in accordance with the contract, even though in some cases owing to contract having expired, supplies are to be executed after the expiry of the last date of contract.

#### **15. DELIVERY PERIOD OF THE PURCHASE ORDER:**

- 15.1 DDOs will send scanned copy of the Purchase order through email or speed post.
- 15.2 Delivery period will be of six weeks from the date of issuing of the purchase order sent by e- mail and the pharmaceuticals firm shall, execute the order within stipulated time.
- 15.3 The firms must supply the pack size as mentioned in Tender Enquiry at the time of delivery.
- 15.4 During transit pharmaceutical firm should maintain the recommended temperature of the drug (wherever indicated), otherwise if on checking it is found that temperature has not been maintained, supply against the said order is liable to be rejected and cancelled. It will be counted as a non-supply.
- 15.5 In case of failure to supply, the Corporation reserves the right to purchase the stocks from other sources as risk purchase, i.e. purchase from any other pharmaceutical firm or firms, in the rate contract or from outside the contract at the discretion of the Direct Demanding Officer concerned at a competitive rate or from local chemist.
- 15.6 In all contracts for items/ drugs, which are branded with "**ESI Supply, not to be sold**" mark including rejected items/ drugs, it would be a condition that such items/ drugs will not be sold to the public/open market.

#### **16. PENALTY FOR NON-SUPPLY / LATE SUPPLY:**

- 16.1 If the pharmaceutical firm fails to execute the supply order within the stipulated period of six weeks, a penalty of two (2%) per cent of the value of the order calculated at the contract rate per week or a part of a week will be levied. The maximum penalty for late supply shall not exceed 10% of the total value of the order/orders.
- 16.2 A pharmaceutical firm can seek extension of the delivery period with the prior consent of the Director Demanding Officers, if it is not in a position to execute the order in time. Such extension is permissible for a maximum period of 5 weeks only but penalty will be levied. That extension of delivery period cannot be claimed as a matter of right but will be at the discretion of concerned Officer.
- 16.3 If the items/ drugs are not supplied by the schedule date (as indicated above or by the extended date) full or in part, the order in respect of the quantity not supplied is liable to be cancelled at the risk and expense of pharmaceutical firm.

**16.4 The extra expenditure involved in procuring supplies from elsewhere, i.e. L-2 firms/ Local Purchase/other running Govt. contract etc. will be recoverable from pharmaceutical firm, in full at discretion of Direct Demanding Officer**

The recoveries thus due will be deducted from any sum payable by the Direct Demanding Officer or which at any time thereafter may become payable under this contract or any other contract placed with bidder by the Direct Demanding Officers. He will be deemed to be exercising the powers of Director General, ESI Corporation in case any such contingency arises.

16.5 Apart from risk purchase action, the bidder's the performance security deposit may be forfeited and shall invite other penal action, like debarring from participating in ESI Corporation rate contract present and future for a period of not less than **two** years.

16.6 If the pharmaceutical firm fails to execute the supply order three times at any location of ESIC / ESIS in any part of the country during the period of rate contract, it shall be debarred for the next **two** years with effect from the last failure and forfeiting of Performance Security.

**17. QUOTING OF PRICE:**

17.1 The price must be quoted F.O.R Destination per unit as shown in the schedule annexed and should be exclusive of Good and Services Tax (GST) but inclusive of all other charges.

17.2 GST, if extra, where legally liveable and intended to be claimed, should be distinctly shown separately along with the price quoted. Where this is not done, no claim of GST will be admitted at any later stage and on any ground whatsoever.

17.3 The purchaser will not pay separately for transit insurance and the bidder will be responsible for delivery of items covered by the supply order in good condition at the specified destination and for this purpose freight, insurance, octroi etc., if any, will have to be borne by the bidder.

17.4. The consignee will, as soon as possible, but not later than 30 days of the date of arrival of stores at destination, notify the pharmaceutical firm, of any loss damage to the stores that may have occurred during the transit.

17.5 If you are indicating 'No Tax' while quoting rate for any drug, upload a copy of certificate issued from the concerned **GST** authority in support of Tax Exemption granted for the drug. The certificate should clearly show whether tax exemption is granted for particular drugs or for all the drugs manufactured by the firm.

**18. PAYMENT:**

18.1 Payment for the supply will be made within 4 to 6 weeks (after receipt and acceptance of the drugs/items) directly by the Direct Demanding Officers or through nominees to whom bills are submitted. Notwithstanding any omission or shortcoming in the supply order it is incumbent upon the pharmaceutical firm/bidder to supply the items as per the specifications of the relevant rate contract. No Claim for the payment from the firms/supplier shall be entertained after the lapse of three years of arising of claim.

18.2 Any dues or payments that have arisen to the Corporation from the pharmaceutical firm for which no specific time limit has been laid down in the terms and conditions shall be payable by the pharmaceutical firm within such time limit as may be prescribed in the letters/orders addressed to the pharmaceutical firms.

18.3 Any payments that have been demanded as per the provisions of above clause or under any other clause shall be payable within the time laid down, On failure to do so:

- The pharmaceutical firm shall be liable to be debarred for supplying items/ drugs etc. to the Corporation for a period not exceeding **two** years.

- The Corporation reserves its right to take appropriate legal action against the defaulting firms as may be legally advised, including claim for compensation and damages for the period of delay and / or simple interest of 10% per annum for each day of default.

## **19. ARBITRATION:**

- 19.1 In the event of any dispute or difference arising under these conditions or any special conditions or contract or in connection with this contract, except as to any matters the decision on which is specially provided for by these or special conditions the same shall be referred to the sole arbitrator duly appointed as per the provisions of The Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 and as amended from time to time and the rules made thereunder and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The venue of the Arbitration will be Delhi only. The Arbitration will be conducted in English language. The award of the Arbitral Tribunal shall be final, conclusive and binding on the parties to the agreement.
- 19.2 Work under the contract shall, if reasonably possible, continue during the arbitration proceedings and no payment due to or payable by the purchaser shall be withheld, on account of such proceedings.
- 19.3 Notwithstanding any omission or shortcoming in the supply order it is incumbent upon the pharmaceutical firm/bidder to supply the items as per the specifications of the relevant rate contract.
- 19.4 Where the tender is awarded to MSE, Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 may not apply, in view of Sec. 18(3) and 18 (4) of MSMED Act 2006, where Facilitation Council under MSMED Act 2006 has been given power for Conciliation and Arbitration (where one party is MSE).
- However, this issue is pending in Hon'ble Supreme Court and Judgment is reserved. Though nothing wrong in retaining this Provision as such. But this must be kept in mind.

## **20. JURISDICTION:**

All the disputes relating to this tender enquiry and Rate Contract shall be subject to the **territorial jurisdiction of Courts at Delhi only.**

## **21. RATE REVISION:**

Successful bidders shall not be entitled to any rate revision for any reason except that allowed by Government of India.

## **22. INSPECTION:**

The Director General, ESI Corporation, reserve the right for Inspection of the pharmaceutical firms participating in the tenders, by the officers appointed. They can carry out inspection for assessing the quality /capacity/capability/eligibility of the pharmaceutical firm to make supplies on the basis of ESI Rate Contract and to ensure that the provisions of the Drugs and Cosmetic Act, 1940 and the good manufacturing practices are being followed by firm. The decision of the Director General shall be final in this regard.

## **23. ORIGINAL LABEL/S :**

- 23.1 All Original Label/s of quoted Ayurvedic drugs should be submitted along with EMD & Annexure H in the Tender box.
- 23.2 Original Label/s of all quoted drugs should bear Drug manufacturing License No. (as quoted in the bid), Details of the manufacturer and drug composition & other mandatory requirements as per Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and Rules 1945 & The Legal Metrology Act, 2009 and rules thereunder. **Photocopy/Laser prints of labels will not be considered. The original labels must be furnished by the stipulated date and failure to do so shall entail the firm's quotation being disqualified.**

23.3 All the Original Label/s should be submitted after pasting neatly on the plain paper (A4 size)

**24. PHARMACOPOEIAL SPECIFICATIONS AND CLASSICAL REFERENCES:**

Ayurvedic Pharmacopoeia of India (API) should be clearly mentioned against each drug/constituent of the formulation quoted as per the provisions of Drug and Cosmetics Act, wherever applicable.

Reference has been mentioned for each classical formulation. However, bidder may also quote formulation based on reference from any of the books from authoritative classical literature as per First Schedule of Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940.

**25. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

**25.1 Signing of the tender:**

The tender is liable to be rejected if complete information is not given therein or if the particulars and date (if any) asked for in the schedule to the tender are not filled in. Individual signing the tenders or other documents connected with the contract must specify whether he signs as: -

- A. A sole proprietor of the pharmaceutical firm or constituted attorney of such sole proprietor.
- B. A partner of the pharmaceutical firm, if it be a partnership firm in which case he must have authority to refer to arbitration disputes concerning the business of the partnership/agreement or a power of attorney.
- C. Authorized Signatory if it is a company; please enclose the resolution of board of Directors.

25.2 Any concealment, misrepresentation on the part of the pharmaceutical firm shall warrant strict action which may extend to cancellation of the tender or subsequent award. Such cancellation shall be at the sole risk of the firm / individual signing the tender or submitting any other document.

25.3 In case of 25.1 (B) a copy of partnership agreement attested by a Notary Public should be furnished unless the same has been previously furnished to the Corporation, or an affidavit on stamped paper by all the partners admitting execution of the partnership of the general power of attorney should be furnished.

25.4 In the case of partnership firms, where no authority to refer disputes concerning the business of the partnership has been conferred on any partner, the tender and all other related documents must be signed by each partner of the pharmaceutical firm.

25.5 A person signing the tender form or any documents forming part of the contract on behalf of another shall be deemed to warrant that he/she has authority to sign the same and, if on enquiry it appears that the person so signing had no authority to do so, the purchaser may without prejudice to other civil and criminal remedy cancel the contract and hold the signatory liable for all costs and damages.

**25.6 The tender may be rejected if:**

- A. A pharmaceutical firm submits conditional tender.
- B. "No tax" quotations are not supported by a proof.
- C. All the documents/annexures etc are not complete.
- D. More than one type of rates are quoted for one product.
- E. Sealed envelope containing EMD is not sealed properly.
- F. If it is not legible and cuttings/over writings are not attested by the authorized signatory along with seal.
- G. The rates quoted are not found both in figures and words.

H. The rates are quoted for unit different from that asked in this tender.

- 25.7 Each page of photocopy of various documents/certificates attached should be self-attested by Authorized Signatory with stamp. It is mandatory that all affidavits are notarized & should also bear signature of Authorized Signatory.
- 25.8 It is mandatory for all bidders to submit the tender online through **e-procurement portal of NIC-<http://eprocure.gov.in>. *The terms & conditions of the present e-Tender Enquiry Form for Rate Contract are binding upon the Pharmaceutical firms / Bidders. The submissions of the online tender and the tender under sealed envelope respectively shall construe a concluded agreement for the purpose of invocation and enforcement of the terms & conditions of the online tender.***
26. The sealed envelope containing EMD as calculated or MSE Certificate, Integrity Pact and Original Label/s of quoted drugs should be addressed to:
- 26.1 Dy. Medical Commissioner (Ayush) at Room No. 315, (3<sup>rd</sup> floor), ESIC Hqrs. Office, Panchdeep Bhawan, CIG Road, New Delhi -110002. Such sealed cover should be dropped in tender box before the last date & time.
- 26.2 A sealed cover containing EMD or MSE Certificate, Integrity Pact and & Original Label/s of quoted drugs will be opened manually on the specified date and time.
- 26.3 Online Price Bid of only those bidders, who are found technically eligible will be opened. The date and time of opening of the price bid in respect of bidders who fulfil eligibility criteria will be intimated to such bidders.
27. Withdrawal of tenders: -
- Withdrawal of tenders along with the earnest money will be allowed before the date of opening of tenders.
28. After opening of tenders:
- Withdrawal of the complete tender can be allowed after opening of tender but in such cases; the earnest money should be forfeited in full.
  - Partial withdrawal (in respect of one or more drug(s) quoted) will not be allowed under any circumstances.
  - No change/alteration in rate or other terms & conditions in the tender will be permitted under any circumstances;
- 29. Force Majeure:**
- If at any time during the applicability of Contract the bidder fails to discharge its Obligation due to force majeure (natural disaster or act of God etc.) he will promptly notify the Director General or its representative about the happening of such an event. The Director General or its representative is solely entitled to terminate/ determine the order/contract in respect of such performance of the bidder(s) obligations if he so desires and the decision of Director General ESIC shall be final. The obligations under the contract on behalf of bidder for the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after the event has come to an end or ceased to exist.
30. If it is found that a drug or a combination of drugs given in the Drug Schedule is not approved by State Drug Controller/Licensing Authority, the same may be withdrawn/ cancelled at any point of the time during rate contract period.



### 31. EVALUATION OF THE TENDER:

The tender will be evaluated as per terms and conditions given in the tender document and in accordance with GFR, CVC and other guidelines issued by Govt. of India from time to time, in the following order: -

#### 31.1 Pre-qualification:

EMD shall be examined. Only those bidders which have submitted valid EMD/EMD exemption certificate as per requirement of the tender document shall be considered compliant and their technical bids shall be opened.

#### 31.2 Technical Bid Evaluation:

The technical bids submitted by the bidders shall be examined for compliance with the requirement of the tender document. **The participating firm must have a valid WHO-GMP Certificate of the manufacturing site for the quoted drugs. However valid GMP certificate may also be considered where the drugs are not quoted from firms having WHO-GMP Certificate. In the event of firm/s with WHO-GMP certificate being technically eligible for a particular drug, firm/s with only GMP Certificate will not be considered for evaluation for that particular drug.** It is not necessary for a bidder to qualify for all the items for which it has submitted its bid. Price bids of only those items shall be opened which would be found as technically qualified. **In case of drugs against each disease category, drugs will be selected on the basis of ingredients mentioned in the drug schedule complying the mandatory ingredient, followed by 2 out of 4 other ingredients.**

#### 31.3 Price Bid opening and evaluation:

Online Price Bid of only those bidders, who are found technically eligible, will be opened. The date and time of opening of the price bid in respect of bidders who fulfil eligibility criteria will be intimated to such bidders.

Price bids will be evaluated for acceptance by the competent authority, subject to meeting the price reasonability criteria/any other price assessment criteria as per GFR-2017.

The bid compliant with tender specification and quoting the lowest rate per unit as mentioned in BOQ shall be declared L1. Similarly, bidder offering prices will be declared L2 & L3 in that order. L2 & L3 will be kept in reserve, if L1 fails to supply, order will be placed to higher L2 and then to L3 in that order.

In case where two vendors quote same lowest price, then both will be selected as L1 and orders will be placed on 50:50 basis from each location. Likewise, if two vendors quote same second lowest price then both vendors will be selected as L2. Likewise, if two vendors quote same third lowest price then both vendors will be selected as L3.

### 32. Integrity Pact: (Annexure “H” on Rs 100/- non-judicial stamp paper)

Bidders are required to sign the Integrity Pact as annexed with the Tender Enquiry **as Second Party** at the pre-tendering stage as a mandatory pre-bid obligation and submit the Integrity Pact **IN ORIGINAL** along with the Financial and Technical Bids. **ESIC will sign the Integrity Pact as Principal and First Party after opening the bids at a later stage.**

All the bidders are bound to comply with the Integrity Pact clauses. Bids submitted without signing the Integrity Pact will be void ab initio and shall be treated as rejected without assigning any reason. **The Bidder has to sign as second party in designated space in addition to attestation of**

**documents.**

33. The provision of Public Procurement Policies (policies relating to Make in India, MSME inter alia) shall be applicable in the tendering process.
34. Bank Mandate form of the firm should be submitted for E.C.S purpose as per Annexure “I”.
35. The bidder should mandatorily inform if there is any change in Bank details/ Authorized Signatory of the firm during the currency of the tender.

**36. Right to Intellectual Property and confidentiality: -**

This Tender document and associated correspondence are subject to data protection and copyright laws and shall always remain the property of the Procuring Entity and must not be shared with third parties or reproduced, whether in whole or part, without the procuring entity's prior written consent.

This condition shall also apply to bidders who do not submit a bid after downloading it or who are not awarded a contract in the process.

The provision of this clause shall survive completion or termination for whatever reason of the tender process or the contract.

**37. GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL SYSTEM:**

Each complaint/representation/grievance must be accompanied by a fee of Rs.10000/- (non-refundable) in the form of Demand Draft from Scheduled Commercial Bank only (RBI approved list annexed with this tender enquiry), in favour of the “ESI Fund Account No. 1” payable at Delhi and bearing address, contact no. & valid email ID of the complainant shall be addressed.

Only a bidder who has participated in the concerned tender process/bidding can submit a complaint/representation/grievance. An application for review concerning the financial bid can be filed only by a bidder whose technical bid has been qualified.

The complaint/representation/grievance must be accompanied by a forwarding letter duly signed by the Authorised Signatory of the firm which the complainant is representing.

Any complaint which is pseudonymous/anonymous and/ or received without fee will not be entertained.

ESIC shall convey the final decision to the complainant after complete evaluation of the complaint. No response shall be given regarding the confidential process of evaluating the bids and awarding the contract before the award is notified, although the complaint shall be kept in view during such process.

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE BID SUBMISSION:**

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>

### **A. REGISTRATION**

- 1) Bidders are required to enrol on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>) by clicking on the link “**Online bidder Enrolment**” on the CPP Portal **which is free of charge**.
- 2) As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique user name and assign a password for their accounts.
- 3) Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- 4) Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register **their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage)** issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.
- 5) Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

### **B. SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS**

- 1) There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, Organization Name, Location, Date, Value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as Organization Name, Form of Contract, Location, Date, Other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- 2) Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective, “MyTenders” folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / e-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- 3) The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

### **C. PREPARATION OF BIDS**

- 1) Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.
- 2) Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents - including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
- 3) Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF/JPG formats. Bid documents

may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

- 4) To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use “My Space” or „Other Important Documents” area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the “My Space” area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

#### **D. SUBMISSION OF BIDS**

- 1) Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that they can upload the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- 2) The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.

***Preamble***

The Principal intends to award, under laid-down organizational procedures, contract(s) for DG ESIC Rate Contract No. .... The Principal values full compliance with all relevant laws of the land, rules, regulations, economic use of resources, and of fairness/ transparency in its relations with its Bidder(s) and/ or Contractor(s).

In order to achieve these goals, the Principal will appoint Independent External Monitors (IEMs) who will monitor the tender process and the execution of the contract for compliance with the principles mentioned above.

**Section 1 - Commitments of THE PRINCIPAL**

- (1) The Principal commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:
  - a) No employee of the principal, personally or through family members, will in connection with the tender for, or the execution of a contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
  - b) The Principal will, during the tender process treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal will in particular, before and during the tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential/ additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the tender process or the contract execution.
  - c) The Principal will exclude from the process all known prejudiced persons.
- (2) If the Principal obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the IPC/PC Act, or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can initiate disciplinary actions.

**Section 2 - Commitments of the Bidder(s) / Contractor(s)**

- (1) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) commit themselves to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) commit themselves to observe the following principles during participation in the tender process and during the contract execution.
  - a) The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to any of Principal's employees involved in the tender process or the execution of a contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/she is not legally entitled to,

in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the tender process or during the execution of the contract.

- b) The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidders into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.
- c) The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act; further the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information or document provided by the Principal as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
- d) The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the name and address of the Agents/representatives in India, if any. Similarly, the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall furnish the name and address of the foreign principals, if any. Further, all the payments made to the Indian agent/ representative have to be in Indian rupee only.
- e) The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will, when presenting their bid, disclose any and all payments made, is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract.
- f) Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) who have signed the Integrity Pact shall not approach the Courts while representing the matter to IEMs and shall wait for their decision in the matter.
- (2) The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.

### **Section 3- Disqualification from tender process and exclusion from future contracts**

If the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s), before award or during execution has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2 of the Integrity Pact, or in any other form such as to put their reliability or credibility in question, the Principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) from the tender process or take action as per the terms & conditions of the related Tender Enquiry.

### **Section 4 – Compensation for Damages.**

- 1) If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the tender process prior to the award according to Section 3 of the Integrity Pact, the Principal is entitled to demand and recover the damages equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit/ Bid Security as per the terms & conditions of the related Tender Enquiry.
- 2) If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3 of the Integrity Pact, or if the Principal is entitled to terminate the contract according to Section 3, of the Integrity Pact, the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover the damages from the Contractor liquidated damages of the Contract value or the amount equivalent to Performance Bank Guarantee as per the terms & conditions of the Tender Enquiry.

### **Section 5- Previous Transgression**

- 1) The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last three years with any other Company in any Country conforming to the anti-corruption approach or with ESI

Corporation/any Government institution / Public Sector Enterprise/ Autonomous institution in India that could justify his exclusion from the tender process.

- 2) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the tender process or action can be taken as per the terms & conditions of the related Tender Enquiry.

#### **Section 6 - Equal treatment to all Bidder(s) / Contractor(s)/ Subcontractor(s)**

- 1) In case of Sub-contracting, the Principal Contractor shall take the responsibility of the adoption of Integrity Pact by the Sub-contractor.
- 2) The Principal will enter into agreements with identical conditions as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.
- 3) The Principal will disqualify from the tender process all bidders who do not sign this Pact or violate its provisions.

#### **Section 7– Criminal charges against violating Bidder(s) / Contractor(s)/ Subcontractor(s)**

If the Principal obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder/ Contractor / Subcontractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder/ Contractor / Subcontractor, which constitutes corruption, or if the Principal has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the same to Chief Vigilance Officer.

#### **Section 8 - Independent External Monitor**

- (1) The Principal reserve the right to appoint competent and credible Independent External Monitor for this Pact after approval by Central Vigilance Commission or any other authority authorized as per prevalent Government of India instructions. The task of the Monitor is to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this agreement.
- (2) The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his/her functions neutrally and independently. The Monitor would have access to all Contract documents, whenever required. It will be obligatory for him/ her to treat the information and documents of the Bidders/ Contractors as confidential. He/ she reports to the Director General, Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC).
- (3) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all tender related documentation of the Principal including that provided by the Contractor. The Contractor will also grant the Monitor, upon his/her request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to their tender related documentation. The same is applicable to Subcontractors.
- (4) The Monitor is under Contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s)/ Sub-contractor(s) with confidentiality. The Monitor has also signed declarations on “Non-Disclosure of Confidential Information” and of “Absence of Conflict of Interest”. In case of any conflict of interest arising at a later date, the IEM shall inform Director General, Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) and recuse himself/ herself from that case.
- (5) The Principal will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the tender proceedings provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations between the Principal and the Contractor. The parties offer to the Monitor to option to participate in such meetings.

- (6) As soon as the Monitor notices, or is of the prima facie opinion, a violation of this agreement, he/she will so inform the Director General, Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) and request Director General, Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) to discontinue or take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The Monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action.
- (7) The Monitor will submit a written report to the Director General, Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) within 4 to 6 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the Principal and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.
- (8) If the Monitor has reported to the Director General, Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC), a substantiated suspicion of an offence under relevant IPC/PC Act, and the Director General, Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) has not, within the reasonable time taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Chief Vigilance Officer, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner.
- (9) The word “**Monitor**” would include both singular and plural.

### **Section 9 - Pact Duration**

This Pact begins when both parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor 12 months after the last payment under the contract, and for all other Bidder's six months after the contract has been awarded. Any Violation of the same would entail disqualification of the bidders and exclusion from future business dealings.

In any claim is made/ lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified above, unless it is discharged/ determined by Director General, Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC).

### **Section 10 - Other Provisions**

- 1) This agreement is subject to Indian Law. Place of performance and jurisdiction is where the Headquarters Office of the Principal is situated, i.e. New Delhi at present. However, the Principal also reserves the right to decide any other place where any other sub office of the Principal is situated.
- 2) Changes and supplements as well as termination notices need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
